Cyber Security Conclave 3.0

Today, Society for Cyberabad Security Council has conducted its third Cyber Security Conclave at Hotel Novotel-HICC.

The event started by an informal interaction with major companies CEOs, COOs and CIOs by Mr Jayesh Ranjan, IT Secretary and other officials of IT department over breakfast.

The session got inaugurated by Mr Jayesh Ranjan, IT Secretary, Mr G T Venkateswara Rao, IRS, Commissioner of Police Sandeep Shandilya, Commissioner of Police Rachakonda, Mahesh Bhagwat, Mr Roland Cloutier, CIO, ADP, Brig General Doron Tamir and Mr Bharani K Aroll Secretary, SCSC.

Mr Bharani K Aroll welcomed the delegates & speakers. In his address he said " We have been getting overwhelming support from the IT industry on our various initiatives of Cyber Security. We have come up with a 4 point agenda for our Cyber Security initiatives - They are Government & industry partnership. Hands on workshops for Cyber security professionals, Awareness campaigns for end users in the form of awareness sessions thru videos and other means and last one being thought leadership sessions for enterprises" .

During the inaugural session, Mr Jayesh Ranjan, IT Secretary in his address said "despite being the youngest state, we have several policies in place which is very important to have as a government and we are implementing the policies effectively" .

Dr Rudra Murthi, CIO, Ministry of Home Affairs, in his address said " India has created the national cyber security police in 2013 and in 2014 issued guidelines on national information security & guidelines - today the challenges in India is creating a one organization for Cyber Security instead of multiple agencies trying to handle the cyber security issue"

Brig Gen. Doron Tamir in his address, shared the Israeli experience on how that Israel has become a Cyber Security Super power - by first creating the Government Defense project way back in 1999 and continued with setting up of The National Cyber Directorate to tackle issues on cyber Security. He has quoted some statistics about Israel Cyber Security - Has more than 250 start-up companies, 5 academic research centres, as Cyber Security industry size has done more than 7 billion US \$ in exports, has close to 30 International R & D centres. He has suggested 4 steps for any country to become a cyber power - Create strong Entrepreneurship Programs, Good Academic research, setting up cyber schools to educate people and efficient Cyber Services.

Addressing the media at the 3rd Cyber Security Conclave, Mr. Roland Cloutier, Staff VP and Chief Security Officer of ADP said, "The Cyber Security is not just only about the firewalls but about the sustainability and continuity for any organization whether it is Government, ITeS or Manufacturing. The jobs of the security officers is focussed on protecting the businesses that they serve every day. However, the fundamentals that we need to always remember are People, Process & Technology."

More than 450 IT professionals have attended the session including 70 senior police officers who have been given various inputs on Cyber Security threats and measures available, precautions to be taken by the police by Dr Rudra Murthi, CIO, Ministry of Home affairs & Brig Gen Doron Tamir.

Lot of IT professionals have expressed satisfaction about the wide array of topics presented and appreciated the quality of speakers. The speakers are from some reputed consultancy organizations like E & T, Deloitte, KPMG, besides organizations like Dr Reddys, Cyient, CA technologies, etc.
