Cyberabad police apprehends interstate chain snatcher

Arrest of a notorious interstate snatcher by Police Cyberbad and detected (18) snatching cases of PS Miyapur, Chandanagar and KPHB and recovered 47 tulas of gold and one bike worth of Rs. 15,00,000/-

Amol Bala Saheb Shinde @ Amol S/o Bala Saheb, 24 years, Caste: Maratha, Occ: Driver R/o Yeshwanth Nagar, Khanapur Tq., Parbhani District Maharashtra State.

PROFILE OF THE ACCUSED

The accused is a native of Parbhani of Maharashtra state and passed 10th class. Presently he is eking out livelihood by working as a private driver. He has three sisters and all are married and settled. The accused is staying along with his parents at Parbhani and addicted to bad vices. He wanted to earn easy money to meet his lavish expenditure.

PREVIOUS CRIMINAL HISTORY

Accordingly he planned to commit property offences of chain snatchings and started committing offences at Parbhani in 2013. He was arrested by Police Parbhani and sent to Jail. After release from jail, he went to Aurangabad there he committed (4) chain snatchings in Aurangabad in the year 2014 and arrested by Police Aurangabad. He released from jail in the same year. After lapse of one year, again he started chain snatchings and committed (5) offences in Lathur of Maharashtra in the year 2016 and arrested by Lathur Police and sent to jail.

CRIMINAL ASSOCIATION AND KNOWLEDGE OF HYDERABAD

When the accused was in Lathur jail, he came in contact with another criminal Sanjay Hakani Jadhav at Lathur jail. During the discussion, Sanjay Hakani informed to the offender that the Telugu people wear lot of gold chains. Based on the information provided by Sanjay Hakani, the offender decided to commit offences at Hyderabad. After release from jail, he purchased Bajaj Discover motor cycle No.MH-22-Y-9972 on the name of his friend Anil. After committing some offences he started using another motorcycle MH22AE 0902 yamaha FZ with red seat cover.

OFFENCES IN CYBERABAD

In order to execution of his plan for snatching of gold chains, in the month of August, the offender came on his bike from Parbhani to Hyderabad during Ganesh festival and committed (5) snatchings in KPHB PS limits and (3) snatchings in the limits of Miyapur PS. Subsequently the offender again came to Hyderabad and committed (3) snatchings in the limits of KPHB and one snatching in the limits of Miyapur P.S. Finally the offender came to Hyderabad on 6-1-2018 and stayed in Gayathri lodge, KPHB. During this period the offender committed two snatchings in Miyapur, one snatching in Chandanagar and two snatchings in KPHB. In all the accused has committed (17) snatchings in the limits of Chandanagar, Miyapur and KPHB.

MODUS OPERANDI OF THE CRIMINAL:

The accused select the place and conduct recce the area and target old aged ladies particularly isolated ladies in the colonies while they were going to temples & shops. Once he targets the ladies he overtakes the lady and comes in opposite direction and snatches the chain with his left hand and flee from the scene of offence.

EFFORTS BY POLICE

The accused went on spree in committing snatching offences which resulted a sense of insecurity among the citizens particularly women community. The Police Cyberabad has taken it as a challenge and teams were on to nab the offender. The teams have made sustained efforts and collected CCTV footage in all the offences and got his clear pictures which made Police to get the descriptive particulars of the accused. Wide publicity was given in the locality and also Print and electronic media. During the checking of lodges, Police collected actionable information from a lodge at KPHB. Based on the information, CCS Teams of Madhapur laid trap in Parbhani and also suspected lodges in Kukatpally and KPHB area. Finally the teams laid hands on the accused on 27-1-2018 at 0600 hours at Gayathri Lodge, Road No.1, KPHB.

During the interrogation, the accused has confessed above offences in the limits of Chandanagar, Miyapur and KPHB. In pursuance of his confession, the following properties were recovered from his possession as mentioned below.

Remaining property is yet to be recovered from the receiver at Parbhani. There are warrants are pending against the accused in Aurangabad and Lathur. So far the accused committed more than (28) cases of snatchings in Maharashtra, Karnataka and Telangana. As the accused habituated to commit the offences, the Cyberabad Police will invoke provision of PD act against the accused.

With the arrest of the serial snatching offender Amol Bala Saheb Shinde @ Amol S/o Bala Saheb, 24 years, Caste: Maratha, Occ: Driver R/o Yeshwanth Nagar, Khanapur Tq., Parbhani District Maharashtra State has given great sigh of guilt to the citizens especially women community.
