CYBERABAD POLICE CO-ORDINATION MEETING WITH SCHOOL PRINCIPALS AND MANagements



A co-ordination meeting was held today on 29.08.2025, at the Cyberabad Police Commissioner Office Main Conference Hall.

The meeting was chaired by Cyberabad Jt. CP Traffic Dr. Gajarao Bhupal, IPS., along with various school principals and management representatives, to discuss traffic-related issues arising from school transportation.

The following key issues were discussed During the meeting:

- ☐ Schools should encourage more students to use school buses instead of private cars to reduce vehicle rush.
- ☐ Heavy traffic near schools and U-turns during peak hours remains a major concern and needs immediate attention.
- ☐ Proper planning of bus routes is required so that buses don't overlap on the same roads and cause congestion.
- ☐ Limiting private vehicle use by parents will help in maintaining smooth traffic flow around schools.
- ☐ Staggering school timings can reduce pressure on roads by avoiding all schools releasing students at the same time.
- ☐ Car pooling and awareness programs for parents will help in controlling the number of vehicles on the roads.
- ☐ Bus drivers and conductors must undergo alcohol tests regularly to ensure complete safety of school children.

- Traffic Police will provide assistance with signals and regulate movement of school buses during peak hours.

- Schools should issue clear transport guidelines and circulate awareness material among parents.

- Both schools and parents must cooperate with traffic police to ensure safe and smooth traffic management for everyone.

The meeting was attended by Madhapur Traffic DCP Sai Manohar, Madhapur Traffic ACP Chandrashekar Reddy, SCSC CEO Naved Khan, and representatives from schools, including Sancta Maria International School, Phoenix Greens International School, Global Edge School (Narsingi), Delhi Public School (Nanakramguda), Chirec International School (Masjid Banda), Meridian School (Madhapur), Oakridge International School (Nanakramguda), NASR School (Gachibowli), Sreenidhi International School, Birla Open Minds International School, Pallavi International School, Sriram International School and other schools.
