



Special Drive Against Banned Chinese Manja in Kukatpally Zone



Crackdown on Illegal Sales: 45 Shops Raided, 5 Cases Registered

Kukatpally Zone: In view of the safety of citizens, motorists, and birds, the Kukatpally Zone Police conducted a comprehensive special drive against the sale and usage of banned Chinese Manja (Synthetic/Nylon glass-coated thread).

Special teams were formed across all 7 Police Stations in the Zone: Balanagar, Allapur, Miyapur, Madhapur, Raidurgam, KPHB, and Kukatpally.

Enforcement Actions: Police teams conducted surprise raids on 45 kite shops and vendors suspected of selling the banned material. Strict legal action has been initiated against violators. A total of 5 cases has been registered against shopkeepers for selling banned manja.

Kukatpally PS: 3 Cases

Allapur PS: 1 Case

Madhapur PS: 1 Case

Awareness & Safety Measures: Apart from enforcement, the police focused on educating the public. A total of 18 awareness programs were conducted across the zone. Specifically, awareness drives were held at Pipeline Road, Madeenaguda (Miyapur PS limits), Shanthi Nagar (Kukatpally PS limits), and IDPL area (Balanagar PS limits). Police personnel also cleared dangerous manja dangling from trees, electric poles, and residential buildings to prevent accidents.

The police have warned that the manufacturing, sale, storage, and use of Chinese Manja is a punishable offence. Citizens are requested to report any information regarding the sale of banned manja to the local police or Dial 100 immediately.
