

**PRESS NOTE**  
**ARREST OF A CHAIN SNATCHING GANG AND**  
**SEIZURE OF COUNTRY MADE WEAPONS & LIVE ROUNDS**

The sleuths of Cyberabad Police Commissionerate belonging to CCS and Madhapur Zone have busted a chain snatching gang who committed series of chain snatching offences on a single day in Cyberabad Police Commissionerate jurisdiction and seized weapons purchased from Uttar Pradesh state. The sleuths Seized (01) Thapancha with (13) live ammunitions, (01) Revolver with (02) live ammunitions, (02) Mobile Phones, (01) Two-Wheeler, (02) knife's and (03) Gold chains weighing about 47 grams at their instance.

**FACTS OF THE CASE:**

On 25.07.2022 between 1500 to 1700 hrs one chain snatching gang consisting of 03 persons committed offences in the limits of PSs Gachibowli, Kukatpally and Ramachandrapuram in which they snatched gold ornaments from 03 different women walking on road and escaped with booty. Immediately teams of CCS and Madhapur Zone Police were formed for detection and apprehension of this gang.

On 26.07.2022 morning hours two more chain snatching offences took place at Miyapur PS limits. And it came to know that the same offenders committed these offences and after committing offence they proceeded towards BHEL. All the PSs, Patrol Cars and crime teams were alerted, the area was cordoned off by closing all entry and exit gates and Police parties were deployed for vehicle checking at different locations. During this Sri Yadaiah HC, Sri Dheabesh PC and Sri M. Ravi PC of CCS Madhapur identified the offenders moving towards HIG gate, they chased and apprehended the offenders. **In this process one of the accused/ A-1 Ishan Niranjana Neelamnalli attacked and stabbed Sri Yadaiah HC with the knife in multiple places viz., chest, stomach, back side of his body and left hand. Still with great determination and strength, the Head Constable did not leave the offender.**

**DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED:**

A-1) Ishan Niranjana Neelamnalli, S/o. Niranjana C Neelamnalli, Age: 21yrs, Occ: Jobless, r/o Gulbarga, Kalaburagi, Karnataka State.

A-2) Rahul, S/o. Ramappa, Age: 19 yrs, Occ: Student, r/o. Gulbarga, Yadgir Dist, Karnataka State.

The accused persons A1 & A2 also committed offences in Cr.no.389/2022, U/s 307, 353, 332, 324 r/w 34 IPC of Ashok Nagar PS, Kalburgi, Karnataka state on 09/10.07.2022 near Hudnoor Ring Road where **they injured Gurusurthy & Sanjeev Kumar both HC of Karnataka Police beating them on the head with Iron Rods.** They are also accused in

automobile offence in Cr.no 92/2022 U/s 379 IPC in which 13 two-wheelers were recovered from the receiver Patrusha.

Special Teams of CCS, Cyberabad have been formed to apprehend other members of the gang.

**Details of the Seizure:**

1. 01 Thapancha and 13 Live Ammunitions.
2. 01 Revolver and 02 Live Ammunitions.
3. 02 Mobile Phones.
4. 01 Pulsar Bike (Committed theft in Gulbarga).
5. 03 Gold chains weighing about (47) Grams.
6. 02 Knives.

The injured Head Constable Yadaiah is undergoing treatment at AIG Hospital, Gachibowli. He was operated on the same day and his health condition at present is stable. **Telangana Police and Cyberabad Police feels very proud of its officers and for the act of bravery and grit towards their duties, names of Yadaiah and his team would be proposed for suitable medals and rewards.**
