

PRESS NOTE

NABBED INTER STATE 4-WHEELER AUTOMOBILE THEFT GANG AND RECOVERED 15 STOLEN CARS ALL WORTH ABOUT RS. 2,30,00,000/-

Acting upon specific information, the sleuths of Special Operation Team (SOT), Shamshabad Zone along with Rajendranagar Police apprehended three persons viz., 1. **Mohammed Azhar Javeed @ Mamu**, 2. **Mohammed Zaheer**, 3. **Mohammed Aman Khan** and seized 15 stolen 4-Wheeler Vehicles, all worth about Rs. 2,30,00,000/-.

DETAILS OF THE ACCUSED: -

1. Mohammed Azhar Javeed @Mamu S/o Mohammed Javeed Iqbal Age: 35yrs, Occ: Vehicle dealer, R/o: Ahmad Residency, Attapur, Rajendranagar Ranga Reddy, Dist.
2. Mohammed Zaheer S/o Mohammed Basheer age: 21yrs occ: Student R/o: Zuber Residency, Attapur Rajendranagar RR Dist.
3. Mohammed Aman Khan S/o Hyder Khan age:23yrs occ: Student R/o: Near Regal Garden, Alinagar, Bandlaguda, Mailardevpally, RR Dist.
4. Ghulam Nabi, R/o: Sambal, Uttar Pradesh. **(Absconding)**

PROFILE OF THE ACCUSED PERSONS:

The Accused No.01, Mohammed Azhar Javeed @ Mamu is born and brought up in Hyderabad. He dropped out his studies in Intermediate and was searching for a private job, but could not get any job. In the year 2016, on the advice of his own sister, who was staying in Qatar, he went to Qatar and worked as labour in Super markets and Restaurants by staying in his sister's house at Qatar. In the year 2020, the accused returned to India. After arriving India, he searched for many jobs and eventually he observed one Post (Car for Sale) at OLX. Immediately he made a phone call and asked for details. The person, Gulam Nabi who posted the Ad in OLX responded with full details by an offer of selling cars at lesser price and intern he can sell it in Hyderabad for good profit. The accused accepted the offer and went to Delhi and met Ghulam Nabi, who sold one Innova for Rs.4,00,000/- by giving documents of the Vehicle. The accused Azhar brought the vehicle to Hyderabad and transferred the vehicle number and sold it for Rs.6,70,000/-. In this transaction the accused Azhar got the profit of around Rs.2,70,000. Further the accused Azhar contacted the accused Ghulam for more cars. The Accused Ghulam had given two more cars in the same process with clear documents. After some days the accused offered one Toyota Fortuner to Azhar by quoting lesser price. The accused Azhar smelt suspicion on Ghulam, as the fortuner vehicle is very costly and was selling for lesser price. But the accused Ghulam convinced him and offered him to pay only Rs.2,00,000/- for vehicle delivery and remaining amount after getting NOC and other documents from RTO. Subsequently the accused Azhar accepted the offer and brought the vehicle to Hyderabad by paying Rs.2,00,000/-. But the Accused A4 Ghulam did not give the Fortuner Vehicle documents. The accused Azhar made many phone calls

to Ghulam regarding the vehicle documents, but he did not respond properly. Finally, one day the accused Ghulam revealed the facts, that the vehicle is a stolen vehicle and sell it to needy people with fake documents, by saying that documents will be given after getting NOC from the concerned State. The accused A1 Azhar sold the vehicle in Punjab through his Facebook friend Kabeer of Mumbai, by showing Xerox/Fake documents. In this transaction the accused Azhar got good profit. The accused discussed the same with his friends A-2 Mohammed Zaheer and A-3 Mohammed Aman Khan. All together A1 to A3 went to Delhi and met the accused A4 Ghulam Nabi and colluded with him to execute the process of selling theft vehicles in illegal manner.

In this process the accused Ghulam give the stolen vehicles of Delhi to A1 to A3. The same vehicles are being sold in Hyderabad by preparing fake documents. In this illegal process the accused Ghulam sold 14 Vehicles to accused A1 to A3. Subsequently the accused A1 to A3 sold the vehicles at Hyderabad to innocent people. About 4 months back, the accused A1 and A2 were bringing two vehicles from Delhi to Hyderabad and when they reached near Nagpur outskirts, the Police stopped the two vehicles of which one Brezza being driven by the accused Azhar and another Vehicle Baleno by his friend Mujahid. Both the persons were got down from the vehicles to speak to the Police and escaped by leaving the vehicles and came to Hyderabad and informed the accused Ghulam about the same. The accused Ghulam assured them that he can manage the issue with the concerned officials. Further the Police Nagpur arrested the accused person Mujahid and since then A1 to A3 are absconding.

MODUS OPERANDI.

The accused Ghulam commit theft of cars and intimate to A1 to A3. The accused A1 to A3 depart to UP State by Flight or Train and bring the vehicles to Hyderabad. The Accused Ghulam sell the vehicles with Fake/Xerox documents to A1 to A3. Further the accused A1 to A3 sell the vehicles to innocent people by saying that the original vehicle documents will be received after getting NOC from the concerned State and provide the Xerox documents. By believing the words of the accused, the innocent people purchase the said vehicle.

Today i.e. On 28.07.2022 in the evening hours, on receipt of specific information, the joint team of SOT Shamshabad Zone and Staff of PS Rajendranagar intercepted the accused A1 to A3 with stolen Creta car without number plate at Himayathsagar Road, near WALAMTARI under the limits of Rajendranagar PS.
