SOT SHAMSHABAD AND RAJENDRANAGAR POLICE NABBED INTER CITY TWO-WHEELER AUTOMOBILE THEFT GANG, WHO COMMITTTED SERIES OF MOTOR CYCLE THEFTS DURING THE LAST 10 MONTHS UNDER TRI COMMISSIONERATES AND RECOVERED 46 STOLEN VEHICLES ALL WORTH ABOUT RS. 50,00,000/-.

Acting upon specific information, the sleuths of Special Operations Team (SOT), Shamshabad Zone along with Rajendranagar Police apprehended 2 criminals and 2 juvenile boys viz., **1. Mohd Ashwaq @ Kabeer, 2. Mohd Akber and 2 Juvenile boys** and seized **46 stolen motor cycles**, all worth about Rs.**50,00,000/-**.

DETAILS OF ACCUSED:-

1. Mohd Ashwaq @Kabeer S/o Md Qayyam, Age: 20yrs, Occ: Salesman, R/o: Ahmed nagar colony, Bandlaguda, Chandrayangutta, Hyderabad.
2. Mohd Akber S/o Md Raheman, Age: 19yrs Occ: Water supply at Madina market, R/o: Ghouse nagar, Bandlaguda, Chandrayangutta, Hyderabad.
3. Saddam R/o Hyderabad **(Absconding)**.
4. Rizwan R/o Hyderabad **(Absconding)**.
5. Juvenile Boys (02)

PROFILE OF THE ACCUSED PERSONS:

The Accused A1- Mohd Ashwaq @Kabeer is king pin of the gang. The Accused is the resident of Ahmednagar Colony, Bandlaguda, Chandrayangutta and studied up to 10th class and dropped his studies and working at Abeera Collections, Madina Market, Charminar. The accused used to get the salary of Rs.8000/- per month. The accused addicted to bad habits and his earnings are not sufficient for his lavishness. For which he decided to commit theft of motor cycles. Accordingly he took the help of A3, who was resident of the same area and committed the series of motor cycle thefts. In this plan, both were succeeded and gained some money and using for their lavish expenses. Later A1 and A3 contacted his child hood friends A2 & A4 Juvenile boys to expand their thefts. Accordingly A2 to A4 and juvenile boys also agreed and all together committed series of vehicle thefts, under the direction of accused A-1 and A1 used to sell the stolen vehicles to innocent people and share the amount equally.

The Accused A2 was born and brought up in Ahmed Nagar Colony, Bandlaguda, Chandrayangutta. He dropped out from his school and assisting his father in supply of mineral water to various shops at Madina Market, Charminar. Mean time he got contact with his childhood friend A1, who is working as Labour in a cloth store at Madina market. As their earnings were not sufficient to fulfill their desires, they hatched a plan to commit theft of motor cycles to earn easy money.

Previously in the month of January 2022, the accused A2 was arrested in a case in Asif Nagar PS. Even after releasing from the jail, he accused did not change his mindset and continuously committing the theft of motor cycles.

The Juvenile Boy **XXXXXX** was born at Aliza Kotla, Bandlaguda at present residing at Mehdipatnam. He studied up to 9th class at Moghalpura and due to disinterest of studies, he has been working as electrician with his father. The accused is the child hood friend of all other accused persons in this case. As the earnings are not sufficient, the accused contacted A1 for earning easy money. As per the directions of A1, he colluded with the other accused and committed theft of two wheelers.

The Juvenile boy **XXXXXX** was born at Madina and studied up to 7th class and dropped his studies and helping his father in carpenter work. Later he worked in a cloth store (Ahmed Suit shop) Madina. Few months back, he met his child hood friend A2-Akbar at Madina Market, where A2 was supplying mineral water at Madina Market. As such A2 suggested him to leave the job and join in their work. For which Juvenile boy-2 agreed and met their child hood friends (Other accused persons in this case) and indulging in series of motor cycle thefts.

The Accused persons A3 and A4 are residents of Hyderabad city and they are the child hood friends of other accused persons in this case. As per the directions of A1, both the accused persons also involved in this gang and committed theft of bikes.

During their process, the accused A1 used to give directions to other accused for committing theft of bikes and helping them in selling of the stolen vehicles. The accused persons usually sell the stolen vehicles at the cost of Rs.15,000 to 20,000 for each bike. The amount will be shared equally, whoever participated in the theft of the said vehicle.

MODUS OPERANDI

As per their plan they formed into a gang. The accused No.1 Mohd Ashwaq @ Kabeer is kingpin of this gang and on the directions of the accused No.1, the gang execute their plans. The gang members move in the areas of main roads and shopping places in the limits of Cyberabad, Rachakonda and Hyderabad Commissionerates and watch for the vehicles, which have the keys to itself. When they find such vehicle, immediately the accused persons go near the vehicle and one accused will watch the surroundings and other will start the vehicle and both will escape on the stolen bike. The stolen motor cycles are sold at Kamareddy of Nizamabad district, few are sold at Vikarabad and the remaining bikes were sold in Hyderabad to their known persons by suppressing the facts for an amount of Rs. 15,000/- to Rs.30,000/-.

22.07.2022 in the morning hours, on receipt of specific information, the joint team of SOT Shamshabad Zone and Police of PS Rajendranagar caught the accused A1 and A3 with a stolen motor cycle at PDP X roads, under the limits of PS Rajendranagar. On enquiry, they revealed the above details and seized the above vehicles, after that the remaining juvenile boys were apprehended by mufti Police.
